1. Title of the Practice: Environment Upgradation

- 2. Objectives of the Practice
- i) Promotion of tree plantation inside and outside the campus
- ii) Creation of an impact on training and preparing the future generation for a green society
- 3. The Context: Environmental degradation is a fact that cannot be denied. The college appealed to the faculty and non-teaching staff of the college to donate one pot and one sampling to the college. 60 faculty and non-teaching staff participated in this activity.

1. Title of the Practice: All Time Accessibility of Education

- 2. Objectives of the Practice
- i) To make the teaching-learning process accessible to the students beyond college hours and outside the campus.
- ii) To make the necessary study material easily available to all the students.

3. The Context

In the pandemic period, most of the teaching was carried out in online mode. The students were required to use either the PC or Smartphones for attending the lectures. Given the economic situation in this area, many students did not have individual access to these tools. Many students used the one smartphone usually belonging to the head of their family.

4. The Practice

The college asked each teacher to create a WhatsApp group for each class. The lectures were to be recorded and made available to the students on this platform as well as the college website and Microsoft Teams. The students could attend the lectures whenever the smartphone was available in their family. This was usually after the working hours of the family head. The students could watch the recorded lectures and post their queries which would be answered by the teacher concerned. All the learning material was also made available on WhatsApp and Telegram as well as the college website for free download. This solved the problem of accessibility for the students, especially in the pandemic period and also during the period in which they could not attend classes due to their other obligations viz. working on their agricultural land in the sowing and reaping activity.
